

Speed Heater Installation

2007 Honda CB900F7 Hornet

1. Remove seat
2. Remove both left and right side covers
3. Remove air filter intake assembly (3 screws + vacuum hose) on left side of bike



4. Locate wiring harness with plastic weather cover (to left of blue wire)
5. Separate Speed Sensor white plug (Speed Sensor located under air box)
6. Plug each end of Speed Heater harness into corresponding plug and socket
7. Route Speed Heater harness under tank to right side of bike, be careful that Speed Heater harness is not fouled if tank is raised for maintenance.



8. Mount Speed Healer unit on top of battery with supplied velcro
9. Loop Speed Healer harness around existing wiring
10. Plug Speed Healer plug into Speed Healer unit
11. Secure Speed Healer harness at appropriate points so that harness doesn't move, note harness is quite rigid, place harness so that there is no force applied to Speed Healer unit, otherwise it may separate from velcro retainer.



12. If required, route wire with button to handlebars (my installation the wire was attached purely for weather protection, the lead and button were coiled and placed under seat.
13. Note that with side covers in place the Speed Healer can be programmed with just the seat needing to be removed.
14. Program the Speed Healer unit, ride bike :)
